Material List: Intro to Acrylic Painting

- **Brushes** - 1" Flat brush, #8 Round brush, #2 Script (rigger) brush, #1 Fan brush.
- **Paper/Canvas** - #100 Crescent Illustration board and/or 140#/300# Watercolor Paper 12" x 12" up to 16" x 20" sized canvases.
- **Paints** - Liquitex Acrylics - Concentrated (2 oz jar med. viscosity) and/or tube acrylics:
The basic list is Magenta, Burnt & Raw Sienna, Burnt Umber, Cadimium Red, Orange, & Yellow Medium, Cerulean, Colbalt and Prussian Blue, Hookers Green, Mars Black, Yellow Oxide, Dioxazine Purple & Titanium White. Remember you are creating your own palettes so you bring what you like over and above the basic list. Liquid acrylics will be demonstrated as well as QOR (Golden) watercolors and acrylics.
- **Other tools/materials** - Pencils, T-square, 3M magic tape and masking tape, clay scraper or any sharp edged tool or chisel point brush-end to paint brush (used to pull through wet paint to create effects), a ruling pen (drafting tool), mixing tray or disposal palette, and paper towels.
