“TORCH FIRED SILVER METAL CLAY”
Beginner Plus

Time: Fridays from 9:30-12:30

CLASS DESCRIPTION: In this class, students will learn how to fabricate a ring, pendants, and earrings with silver clay. Once students learn how to form the pieces and dry them in a dehydrator, they will then be taught how to torch fire each piece with a butane torch. Instructor will then teach students basic jewelry making techniques to make these sterling silver pieces into lovely pieces of jewelry.

METHOD: Demonstrations, Group Discussion and, Individual Teaching.

3. One Package of 15grams of PMC3 Silver Clay Paste (Rio#100716)
4. Optional: PMC Tool Kit (Rio#111411)
5. Color Quick Thickness Guide Set (Rio#111569)
6. Optional: Makin's Professional Extruder Kit (Rio#111570)
7. PMC Teflon Coated Work Surface (Rio#111565) or Rio PMC Work Surface (Rio#111567)
8. Assorted Nail Files from Sally's (on-line or in store-or Amazon) Pink, Blue and Black grits
